



MASJID ABDULLAH FAHIM, BERTAM KEPALA BATAS

Visit the Masjid Abdullah Fahim, one of the landmarks of Kepala Batas. Beautifully located in Bertam, the mosque was completed on 28 September 2012 and mooted by the Honourable 5th Prime Minister, Tun Abdullah bin Ahmad Badawi.

MASJID JAMEK PERMATANG HAJI HASSAN

Masjid Jamek Permatang Haji Hassan in Permatang Buloh Seberang Perai Utara was built in the 1960s. It has a beautiful and unique architectural design with its majestic black domes. An interesting historical feature of this mosque is an old cannon in its compound.

Masjid Kampung Banggol was built in the 19th century. The architectural design of the mosque is unique as it does not have any dome; a feature as found in most of other mosques.

MASJID TUAN SAMAD PERMATANG SUNGAI DUA

In the 1930s, a religious teacher named Tuan Samad who lived in Permatang Sungai Dua built a mosque. It is known as Masjid Tuan Samad Sungai Dua. The original structure was built using wood while the pillars and the floor were made of limestone.

Kedah Royal Mausoleum is a heritage of the Malay Sultanate of Kedah. This mausoleum was founded by Almarhum Tunku Sulaiman Ibni Almarhum Sultan Abdullah Mukarram Shah before 1821. On 12 November 1821, Armada Siam from Ligor invaded and conquered Kedah. Sultan Kedah at the time Sultan Ahmad Tajuddin Halim Shah II fled from his house in Pulau Tiga to this area and was rescued by his younger brother Tunku Sulaiman before seeking protection from the British in Penang. This area has been designated as an endowment land by the British.

The Nine Emperor Gods Temple is one of the largest temples in Butterworth. Dedicated to the Nine Emperor Gods of Taoist mores, it has gone through several makeovers over the years. It started out as a shrine on a rented plot of land in 1971. The current temple with magnificent architecture completed in year 2000, at the cost of RM7 million.

MASJID JAMEK HAJI ABDUL RASHID SUNGAI DUA



Masjid Jamek Haji Abdul Rashid is noted for its fine wood carvings of floral motif which adorn its windows. According to local people, the mosque already existed in 1950s.

PASAR BISIK KUALA MUDA

Kuala Muda is a place for fishermen to land their boats. Located here is a Pasar Bisik (Whispering Market) where transaction is carried out by whispering between fishmongers and fishermen. The selling system by whispering attracts the attention of many and Pasar Bisik Kuala Muda has become a focal point with the presence of fishmonger from surrounding area including Kedah and Perak.

BATU SEMPADAN BRITISH SIAM PINANG TUNGGAL

The British-Siamese Boundary Stone at Pinang Tunggal, Seberang Perai Utara was built to mark the boundary between the two territories. It was once used to demarcate the territory of the British colony and the Siamese kingdom. At that time, Penang was under the British administration while Kedah was under the rule of the Siamese. The stone was located in the middle of a field far from residential areas.

JAMBATAN MERDEKA BUMBONG LIMA

Jambatan Merdeka is located on the border of Kedah / Penang. The bridge was completed in 1957 to replace the original bridge (1940) that was destroyed by the Japanese Army in 1942. The bridge crosses the river (Sungai Muda) and connects the states of Kedah and Seberang Perai, Penang. It was officiated by Yang Teramat Mulia Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra Al Haj (the 1st Prime Minister of Malaysia) and was named 'Jambatan Merdeka'.
