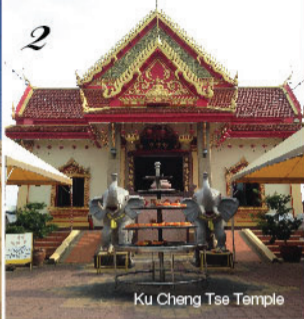

1. Sri Muniswarar Temple

Established in the 1870's this Sri Muniswarar Temple is one of the oldest and situated at Jalan Baru, Prai, Seberang Perai.

2. Ku Cheng Tse Temple

Ku Cheng Tse Temple is a newly built Buddhist temple in Seberang Jaya. The great architecture of the temple emits an image of a Central Thai Temple. Two charging elephants will greet you with happiness once you enter the temple. In the temple, there is a pavilion with donation tablets for the gods and a huge shrine hall for devotees to pay their respects. (Latitude : 5.428295 | Longitude : 100.386958)

5. Tua Pek Kong Zhen Temple, Bukit Mertajam

Located at the heart of Bukit Mertajam, the temple venerates the god of prosperity and guardian of the community. Within the compound of the shrine are a number of hawker food including wantan mee, koay teow thng and laksa.

6. Masjid Jamek Haji Abdul Rashid Kubang Semang

Masjid Jamek Haji Abdul Rashid is noted for its fine wood carvings of floral motif which adorn its windows. According to local people, the mosque already existed in 1950s.

7. Surau Kubang Semang

Another picturesque surau in Seberang Perai is Surau Kubang Semang. The design of the surau resembles a traditional Malay house. The surau is used only during the month of Ramadhan (the Muslim month of fasting) for nightly Tarawih prayers.

8. St Anne's Church

St. Anne Church Bukit Mertajam has existed since 1833, when Chinese and Indian Catholics from Batu Kawan settled in the foothills of Bukit Mertajam. These people were farmers who had come to clear the land for cultivation. The very first Catholic church in Bukit Mertajam, a small chapel, was built on top of the hill between 1840 and 1860. Today, the site of that small chapel is the 15th and final station of the Cross which devotees make in their pilgrimage. (Latitude : 5.440325 | Longitude : 100.387715)

9. Rumah Tuan Guru Haji Othman

Kubang Ulu in the district of Seberang Perai Tengah boasts a heritage building which is reminisced of houses in Mecca. This triple-storey house is more than 100 years old. The house is surrounded by village houses. The house belonged to Tuan Guru Haji Othman, the famous religious teacher around the 1900s. This house is occupied by the third generation of descendants.

10. Batu Bertulis CheroK Tukon

CheroK Tukon is a name of a hill located near St. Annes's Church in Bukit Mertajam. This stone containing inscriptions was founded by Colonel James Low in 1845. Now it is under the care of the Penang Museum and is being preserved in the grounds of St. Anne's Church. There is Brahmi writing on the stone. Batu Bertulis CheroK Tukon is one of the national treasures and has been gazetted as a national heritage site under the National Heritage Act 2005 (Act 645). To preserve the stone, the museum authorities have built a shelter to house and protect it. (Latitude : 5.353762 | Longitude : 100.474426)

11. Empangan Mengkuang

The Mengkuang Dam was officially opened in 1985 with water storage capacity ten times greater than the Air Itam Dam. You can also unwind or go for some sporty adventures at the recreational park within the dam area. (Latitude : 5.384722 | Longitude : 100.506111)

12. Taman Tunku

Taman Tunku is named after our country's first prime minister, Tunku Abdul Rahman and remains as one of the best recreational venue in Butterworth. The park is now lush with greenery along with a jogging track for locals who are up for recreational activities.

13. Penang Bird Park

14. Makam Diraja Kedah

Kedah Royal Mausoleum is a historical heritage of the Malay Sultanate of Kedah that still exists until today. This mausoleum was founded by Almarhum Tunku Sulaiman ibni Almarhum Sultan Abdullah Mukarram Shah since before 1821. On 12 November 1821, Armada Siam from Uigur invaded and conquered Kedah. Sultan Kedah at that time Sultan Ahmad Tajuddin Halim Shah II (1804-1845) fled from his house in Pulau Tiga to this area and rescued by his younger brother Tunku Sulaiman before seeking protection from British in Penang.

The area has been designated as a waqf (endowment) land by the British government in Penang for the Tunku Sulaiman family as a Kedah Royal Mausoleum. Among the Kedah royal family buried in this Kedah Royal Mausoleum were Tunku Sulaiman ibni Almarhum Sultan Abdullah Mukarram Shah and Tunku Kutam.

16. Safira Country Club

17. Juru Auto City

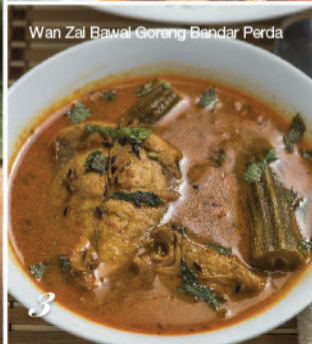

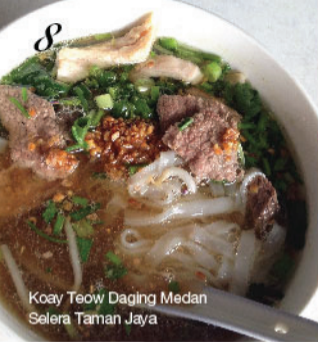

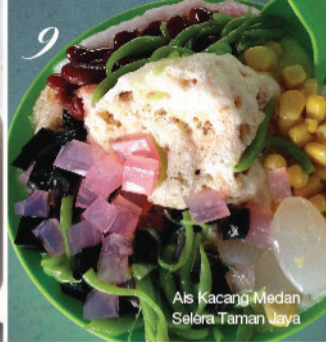
